Upstage Productions, Inc. Postpones *Matilda the Musical* Looking to Reschedule in Fall of 2022

The Board of Directors of Upstage Productions announce that they will unfortunately need to postpone their November production of *Matilda the Musical*. Due to safety precautions surrounding COVID-19, the Board of Education has established that we are no longer able to utilize the auditorium at Hudson High School or any other building within their district. Our hope is to secure the rights to mount the production in the fall of 2022 keeping the cast intact.

Following a successful *Matilda the Musical* workshop this summer that included special guests from the original Broadway and National Touring companies, the full scale production was slated to play at the Hudson High School auditorium November 19, 20, 21 for three performances. Fall 2022 dates will be announced at a later time.

“This was an extremely hard decision to make. The cast was in the midst of rehearsals and we were so excited to tell this amazing story. We tried to secure a new venue and could not, so we had to make this difficult choice. We look forward to presenting this beautiful story here in Columbia County next fall.” said Christine Abitabile, President of the Board.
